Alpine County Plan Strengths:

- For a county population of approximately 1000 residents, Alpine County provided outreach through the use of surveys, informational groups, and a community stakeholder meeting with participation from county staff, community agencies, clients, and family members. The Review Team appreciated that surveys were distributed to the Native-American community.
- Project 1 will provide a classroom-based, social skills program for children ages 4-14 that includes a parent training component. This project will be implemented in all elementary schools, including the Woodfords Indian Education Center.
- Project 2 is an evidence-based practice to develop parenting, child life, and family life skills that will be implemented at the Tribal Wellness Center and available to the Native-American community.
