**Issue:**

The Community Forum Workgroup will debrief the Modesto Community Forum held on December 8, 2011. The discussion will include a review of the introduction, PowerPoint, group questions, break out groups, and group discussion which took place as part of the Modesto Community Forum. The discussion will also include comments on what went well and what were the challenges at the forum. Follow up reports from the forum will be discussed.

In addition to the Modesto Forum debriefing, the Workgroup will discuss planning for the Community Forums in 2012. Included in this planning will be discussion of a date for the San Diego Community Forum of 2012 and a date for the Community Forum Workgroup to meet in October of 2012. For the October Workgroup meeting, a tentative date has been scheduled for October 10, 2012. Please note that the dates for the Orange County Community Forum and San Luis Obispo Community Forum have been switched. The San Luis Obispo Forum will now be held on June 27<sup>th</sup> and the Orange County Forum will be held on September 13<sup>th</sup>. Please also note that the Chico Forum date has been changed to April 4<sup>th</sup>.

**Background:**

The CFLC and CLCC held three MHSOAC Community Forums in 2011. The purpose of these forums was to foster discussion and input regarding the progress and impact of the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA). The three MHSOAC Community Forums were held in various locations throughout California and most of them took place during the evening, allowing stakeholders an opportunity to attend and participate.

To accomplish the goals of the forums, a workgroup consisting of four members each from the CLCC and CFLC Committees was established to plan and conduct MHSOAC Community Forums.
