2	Yolo County's MHSA PEI plan includes a Crisis Intervention Team Training program. The program offers a 32-hour training, is based on the Memphis Model, and is POST-approved. Presently, Yolo County contracts with retired Police Sergeant Michael Summers, of Disability Response, to coordinate these trainings. Yolo County law enforcement agencies do not have actual officer/clinician teams, but through the Mental Health Services Act, Yolo County offers four CIT trainings per year, open to law enforcement personnel from any of our seven local agencies and to local first responders who live or work in Yolo County. Officers or responders from outside Yolo County are allowed to participate on a space-available basis.
