Background:

The CFLC 2013 has a Charter activity regarding the development of strategies for promotion of client and family member employment in the mental health system. At the June 19, 2013 meeting, the Committee discussed the information that is currently available about client, family member employment in the statewide mental health system. The Committee decided to invite multiple organizations involved with these efforts to present an overview to the CFLC and how these organizations are working to expand the role of peer employees, with lived experience as consumers, parents and/or family members in the public mental health system.
