Dr. Todd Gilmer will present preliminary findings from his Evaluation of Full Service Partnerships (FSP) within a group of California Counties.

Todd P. Gilmer, Ph.D.

Todd Gilmer, Ph.D., is Professor of Health Economics and Chief, Division of Health Policy, in the Department of Family and Preventive Medicine at the University of California, San Diego. He received his Ph.D. in economics from the University of Washington in 1997. His research has focused on three areas: health insurance and risk adjustment, diabetes care, and mental health services research. Dr. Gilmer specializes in research design and data analysis, the use of large data sets including those from Medicare, Medicaid, and commercial health plans, national surveys and census data, mixed data sets that combine epidemiological data with health insurance claims, and the evaluation of community based interventions to improve chronic disease care to low-income populations
