ISSUE:

The MHSOAC contracted with researchers at the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) to identify a draft set of priority performance indicators based on those previously adopted by the Commission and the California Mental Health Planning Council. The overarching goal of the UCLA “priority indicators” project is to work with the MHSOAC and its stakeholders to take the first steps needed to enable us to identify a standard set of performance indicators that can be continuously monitored, refined on a regular basis, and used for quality improvement purposes.

The focus of this Workgroup discussion, led by Dr. Renay Bradley, was on indicator calculations for the upcoming report, which will use data for FY 2004/05 and 2005/06. At the workgroup meeting, attendees considered the “best possible options” with regards to calculations of the indicators identified by UCLA and the issues with those options (e.g., whether the issues are acceptable as limitations and/or whether they can possibly be overcome). This report out will provide the Committee with an update on the conclusion of the workgroup and the focus of the upcoming report.
