Authority

- Assembly Bill (AB) 82
 - Signed by the Governor on June 27, 2013
 - Effective immediately
 - Requires the Commission for the first time to issue and adopt regulations for programs and expenditures for:
 - Innovative (INN) programs
 - Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) programs

Process to Date

- PEI/INN Regulation Workgroup
 - Three members from each MHSOAC committee
 - Two meetings
 - Concepts and matrices
 - Proposed draft regulation language

Essential Principles for Drafting PEI/INN Regulations

- Consistent with Administrative Procedures Act
 - Interpret, clarify, and implement the MHSA
- Based on the MHSA
 - Matrices in meeting packet
- Outcomes-focused
- Flexible: supports county/community priorities and wisdom

PEI Framework

- MHSA-specified purpose for PEI: prevent mental illness from becoming severe and disabling
- Required of all PEI:
 - Early Intervention programs
 - Outreach to individuals who recognize early signs of potentially severe and disabling mental illness
 - Creating access and linkage to medically necessary care
 - Emphasizing improving timely access to services for underserved populations
 - Designing/implementing programs in such a way to reduce stigma and discrimination associated with being diagnosed or seeking mental health services

PEI Framework (Continued)

- PEI Efforts may also include:
 - Prevention programs: prevent occurrence, severity, and consequences of serious mental illness for individuals with identified risk factors or for members of a group with demonstrated greater than average vulnerability to mental illness
 - Direct efforts to reduce stigma and discrimination associated with either being diagnosed with a mental illness or seeking mental health services
 - Direct efforts to prevent suicide

PEI Framework (Continued)

- Evaluation Data/Reports
 - Counties measure and report outcomes data
 - Prevention and Early Intervention programs that directly serve individuals
 - County chooses indicators tied to measuring the reduction of prolong severing – one of MHS 7 negative outcome
 - County may also measure reduction of any other 7 negative outcome

PEI Framework (Continued)

- Evaluation Data/Reports
 - Other programs/strategies such as linking individuals to medical treatment or providing timely access to services for underserved populations
 - County reports on a few common indicators

INN Framework

- Overall MHSA Purpose: Projects relate to the prevention of and/or recovery from serious mental illness and must have one of the following as primary purposes:
 - Increase access to underserved groups
 - Increase access to services
 - Increase the quality of services including measurable outcomes
 - Promote interagency and community collaborations

INN Framework (Continued)

- All INN projects:
 - Design, pilot, and evaluate time-limited new or changed mental health practice
 - Infuse new effective mental health practices consistent with 4 MHSAs purposes into overall public mental health system
- Evaluation is key
 - Assess the effectiveness of new or changed practice
 - Final Report

Examples from PEI Matrix

- “Effective in preventing mental illnesses from becoming severe”
- “Outreach” to people “to recognize early signs of potentially severe and disabling mental illnesses”

Example from INN Matrix

- “Transition to another category of funding”
 - Involve stakeholders in decision
- Expenditure Plan/Budget
 - Projection for entire duration of INN (i.e. 4 years) and for each fiscal year
