INN Funding		
1. Clarify that the regulation applies only to INN funding.	PEI/INN Regulations Workgroup (Workgroup) member	1(b) and (c)
INN Project Elements: New or Change Practice		
1. Clarify that a mental health practice that has already demonstrated its effectiveness is not eligible for funding as an INN project.	Workgroup member	2(b)(1) and (2)
INN Project Elements: Time-limited		
1. Delete the word, "intractable" in the description of challenges.	Workgroup member	2(g)
2. Edit the section dealing with continuing an INN project with other funding so as not to provide unrealistic expectations that INN projects will be continued.	Workgroup member	2(f)(4)(A)-(C)
3. For applicable INN projects, counties need to have a plan on how to protect and provide continuity for individuals with serious mental illness who are receiving services from the INN project.	Workgroup member	2(f)(4), (4)(B)
4. For INN projects that provide services for individuals with serious mental illness and are terminated prior to the planned end date, counties need to describe the steps taken to protect and provide continuity of services for those individuals.	Services Committee	2(f)(5)(A)(i), (5)(B), and (6)(A)
5. For INN projects that are terminated prior to the planned end date counties need to notify stakeholders not just the MHSOAC of the termination.	Workgroup member	2(f)(5)(A) and (6)(A)

INN Project Elements: Changed INN Project		
1. Clarify what changes in an INN project require MHSOAC approval before the change is made.	Workgroup member	2(i)
2. Require counties to notify the MHSOAC but not obtain approval to extend the length of an INN project as long as no additional funds are spent.	Workgroup member	2(f)(3) and 2(i)
INN Project Plan		
1. Clarify that information about how a county intends to protect and provide continuity for individuals with serious mental illness only applies to “applicable” INN project.	Workgroup member	3(b)(3)(F)
INN Project Reports		
1. Change the deadline to submit a final INN Project report from “60 days” to “6 months” from the completion of the project.	Workgroup member	4(a)(2)(A)
2. Add “gender identity” to the list of disaggregated data.	Public	4(b)(3)(I)
3. Expand the list of race/ethnicity required to be reported.	Workgroup member	Staff is continuing to work with Commissioners to develop an appropriate level of disaggregate data. See 4(b)(3)(B) and (C).
