Issue:

Paul Taylor, Executive Director of Momentum for Mental Health, will provide information on outcome data for Santa Clara's Full Service Partnership-90 pilot program.

Background:

Full Service Partnership-90 (FSP-90) was first proposed as a pilot program in late 2008 as an alternative service design that would provide an effective community based intervention for persons housed in Institutions for Mental Disease (IMD), Emergency Psychiatric Services (EPS) or Acute Hospitals, and were slated to return to the IMD because of their perceived inability to live successfully in the community. FSP-90 works as a supplement and in partnership with the traditional outpatient service team and serves up to 30 adults (18 and up) who have demonstrated minimal engagement with traditional outpatient mental health supports, for up to 90 days. At the end of 90 days, the traditional outpatient service provider continues to support the consumer with recovery services, including the continued goal of successfully living in the community.
