At the January 23, 2014 Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSOAC) meeting, a presentation focused on Deliverable 1 from the MHSOAC “Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) Component Evaluation” contract with the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) will be presented to the Commission. The deliverable includes a report that describes an evaluation conducted by UCLA focused on achieving the following objectives:

- Assess who is being served by both prevention and early intervention efforts for fiscal year (FY) 2011/12, including a break out of target populations;
- Assess the use of PEI funds for purposes specified in the MHSA (i.e., Welfare and Institutions Code Section 5840);
- Identify the total amount of MHSA PEI funds spent on prevention and early intervention efforts at the State and county level for FY 2011/12.
