Summary: Presentation of findings and recommendations from the “Priority Indicators Trends Report” completed by the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) and TRYLON Associates. The report examined consumer and system level performance of Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) funded programs at the state and county level across multiple fiscal years using existing data. Information contained in the trends report is intended to support ongoing quality improvement and data strengthening efforts throughout California’s publicly funded mental health system. This report represents a critical next step in implementation of an ongoing statewide performance monitoring system for MHSA funded programs and services.
