Approve a Contract with the California Association of Local Mental Health Boards and Commissions

Summary: The Commission will be presented with an outline for a contract with the California Association of Local Mental Health Boards and Commissions (CALMHBC) and Staff is recommending approval of the contract in the amount of \$166,500 for a three year contract.

The CALMHBC is an association that is self supported through contracts, grants, and tax deductible donations.

The purpose of the CALMHBC is to assist local mental health boards to carry out their mandated functions, which include conducting public hearings, and providing recommendations to the county on the county's Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Three Year Program and Expenditure Plans and Annual Updates.

The CALMHBC will help the MHSOAC fulfill its statutory responsibility to assist consumers and family members at the local level to ensure that the appropriate state and county agencies give full consideration to concerns about quality, structure of service delivery, or access to mental health services.

The Contractor will provide support, education, training and technical assistance to consumers and family members serving on local mental health boards and commissions.
