Plan Projects:

This PEI Plan has 3 projects:

- 1) Early Childhood Education Project
- 2) School Based Violence Prevention
- 3) Suicide Prevention and Stigma Reduction

Tuolumne County Plan Strengths:

- The Community Program Planning was commendable, inclusive and engaging. They made focused attempts to reach families, ESL students, Native Americans and LGBTQ communities.
- Tuolumne County used demographic data in a way that measured the success of their outreach efforts.
- The Plan represents the first MHSOAC PEI anti-bullying program.
- The projects were well conceived and clearly based on stakeholder input.
- They leveraged meager resources for their projects and plan to use a train-the-trainer approach which will greatly increase the number of people served and enhances community strengths.
- The projects will affectively address disparities in Tuolumne County and were consistent with creating a healthier social climate for students. The Nurturing Parenting project is well suited to produce positive results for children 0-5 and their parents.
