### Plan Projects:

This PEI Plan has 3 projects:

- 1) PATHS Preschool
- 2) PCIT Community Collaborative
- 3) Older Adult PEI Services

### Inyo County Plan Strengths:

- Inyo County PEI planning process included a survey that was distributed in English and Spanish and the survey respondents closely reflected the cultural composition of the county.
- The Toiyabe Indian Health Project, an organization that provides therapeutic services, prevention strategies, and intervention activities to the Native American population in Inyo County, was an active partner in the PEI planning process.
- Consumers and Youth participated in organizing informational groups and assisted peers with filling out the survey.
- Project #1 encourages parents to become engaged in school activities and offers referral services to preschoolers and families.
- Project #2 will contract with the University of California, Davis for PCIT instruction and follow up services. The equipment needed for PCIT will also be mobile and available to trained partner organizations in the community.
- Project #3 provides voluntary, client-directed, strength-based, wellness and recovery principles in a way that is sensitive to the cultural needs of this population. This project also offers a caregiver support group.
