Plan Projects:

This PEI Plan has 3 projects:

- 1) Access to Services
- 2) Outreach
- 3) PEI for at Risk Children, Youth, and Families

Nevada County Plan Strengths:

- Nevada conducted a Community Program Planning (CPP) process that provided outreach to very remote areas of the county with diverse communities, including Latino outreach.
- The Review Team appreciated the involvement of various consumers from organizations such as the National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI), Depression Bipolar Support Alliance (DBSA), and the SPIRIT Center in the planning process.
- Project #1 includes funding training for first responders and training primary care physicians to screen for mental health issues.
- Project #2 includes a Promotores program to reach the Latino community and programs to outreach to seniors and individuals who are homeless.
- Project #3 includes programs such as school mentors, screenings at schools, and evidence-based practices for early intervention.
