The Client and Family Leadership Committee (CFLC) of the MHSOAC presented a paper and recommendations, at your September meeting, regarding public comment at your Commission meetings. CFRA supports these recommendations and would like to commend the CFLC for their thorough efforts in discussing these issues.

We respectfully request a change on two issues. First, we believe that public comment is essential and should be allotted at least three minutes, rather than two minutes. It is critical that the public have reasonable time to comment on current issues. Further, community stakeholders prioritize and attend OAC meetings and it is quite often at the cost of other competing demands.

Secondly, we support having two (2) periods for general public comment at the Commission meetings, one in the morning and one at the end of the meeting. Both periods provide for more inclusive participation by community stakeholders. Public comment is indeed an essential component in all MHSOAC meetings.
