Issue:

Enclosed for review are the 2003-04 and 2006-07 Disparity Reports.

Background:

The Cultural and Linguistic Competence Committee (CLCC) is tasked with requesting utilization data from the Department of Mental Health (DMH) to determine reductions in disparities. The enclosures contain reports and charts from January 2010, and represent of the prevalence data for serious mental illness in California. These figures are based on Collaborative Psychiatric Epidemiology Surveys (CPES) estimates of need developed by Charles Holzer from the University of Texas. These estimates represent "Targets" and are compared across gender, race/ethnicity, and age to service data obtained through DMH's Client Services Information System (CSI). This information is to be used as background for new CLCC members and to inform the Commission on the progress of disparity reductions. The Mental Health Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSOAC) staff has submitted a letter to DMH requesting updated utilization data for 2007-08 and 2008-09. Additionally, MHSOAC staff has requested that DMH provide a presentation of the most recent data at the June 14, 2011 CLCC meeting.
