Issue:

Review and approve draft process and criteria for identifying educational events that promote mental health awareness and education

Background:

The Cultural and Linguistic Competence Committee’s (CLCC) purpose is to ensure that the perspective and participation of individuals and families who are members of racial, ethnic, and cultural communities are systematically included in all of the Commission’s deliberations, decisions and recommendations.

Per the CLCC 2011 Charter, the CLCC is charged with identifying educational events that occur in 2011 that promote mental health awareness and education for members of racial, ethnic and cultural communities across California. The Committee is also tasked with preparing this information for possible posting and/or translation on the Mental Health Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSOAC) website.

At the February 16, 2011 CLCC meeting, the membership articulated a process and criteria for identifying educational events that promote mental health awareness and education.

Proposed Motion:

The CLCC will adopt the draft process and criteria to identify educational events that promote mental health awareness and education for posting and/or translation on the MHSOAC website.
