**2011 Charter
(Updated 4/4/2011)**

Purpose:

To ensure compliance with Welfare and Institutions Code (WIC) Sections 5846 and 5847 the MHSOAC Services Committee will work on behalf of the Commission in making recommendations regarding the implementation and sustainability of MHSA programs and services to the MHSOAC.

Objectives:

1. Oversee MHSA Services Components, Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) and Innovation (INN) implementation. Purpose and intent follow:
 - To assure adherence of services to regulatory guidelines
 - To identify relevant identify implementation issues plan
 - To assure consistency of reporting for evaluation
2. Review and comment on MHSA Regulations
3. Be responsible for identification of key questions/outcomes to be achieved, using information from evaluations for quality improvement and for recommending changes in service policies
4. Make recommendations for coordination of training and technical assistance necessary to implement and sustain MHSA Service Components
5. Identify and recommend appropriate policies to facilitate implementation and sustainability of MHSA Services

Guiding Principles

Committee policy and strategy recommendations to the MHSOAC should reflect and strive to address the following MHSA-identified priorities:

1. Culturally and Linguistically competent
2. Promotes a client/family/parent driven system
3. Reduces stigma and discrimination
4. Fully informed via a robust stakeholder process
5. Best Practices and continuous improvement
6. Emphasize the inclusion of all ages across the life-span
7. Aim to reduce mental health disparities.

Workplan Activities:

1. Review service trends and MHSOAC program implementation policies – ongoing
2. Review and comment on Innovation Regulations – Begin April, 2011 for May ,2011 MHSOAC – *suspended until further notice*
3. Develop framework for coordination of training and technical assistance – Begin Feb. 2011 for July, 2011 MHSOAC
4. Develop Innovation Trends Report – Begin August, 2011 for Sept. MHSOAC
5. Update 2009 PEI Trends Report – Begin April, 2011 for May, 2011 MHSOAC
6. Participate in work group, convened by the Evaluation Committee Chair, on counties' reporting requirements – August, 2011
7. Convene work group with participants from the Evaluation, Funding and Policy, CLCC and CFLC committees, to develop and implement an integrated plan – Begin April, 2011 for Jan. 2012 MHSOAC – *suspended until further notice*
8. Prepare a draft report highlighting examples of “Transforming the Mental Health System through Integration” - Dec. 2011
9. Initiate work with partners to develop a clearinghouse to disseminate “best practice” programs and training for Co-Occurring Disorders – Dec. 2011
10. Convene a work group with participants from CFLC and CLCC to develop PEI Statewide Reducing Disparities Project guidelines – Begin April, 2011 for Jan. 2012 MHSOAC
