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**Background:**

CalMHSA, a Joint Powers Authority (JPA) acting on behalf of member counties, is administering three Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) statewide programs (Suicide Prevention, Stigma & Discrimination Reduction, and the Student Mental Health Initiative) for the counties that have assigned funds. A contract between the JPA and Department of Mental Health allows CalMHSA to develop and implement the PEI statewide programs in accordance with the Guidelines issued by the Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSOAC) in March 2010.

At the January 27, 2011 Commission meeting, the MHSOAC approved the CalMHSA Workplan for the expenditures of \$123,838,710 on Suicide Prevention, Stigma and Discrimination Reduction, and Student Mental Health. The Commission approval included a request for CalMHSA to provide biannual updates to the Commission.

**Presentation:**

Wayne Clark, CalMHSA Board President will be making the first biannual update presentation on the current status of the PEI Statewide Projects. The biannual update will include an overview of the enclosed Implementation Status Report:

- status of contract awards,
- award recipients,
- synopsis of each contract, including contract outcomes and targeted populations (i.e. Suicide Prevention, Stigma and Discrimination Reduction, and/or Student Mental Health Initiative),
- amounts spent to date, including for administration and planning,
- upcoming Request For Proposal's (RFP) or Request For Qualification's (RFQ).
