BACKGROUND:

A priority identified in the 2011 Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSOAC) Work Plan is to continue the implementation of the accountability framework. The MHSOAC has initiated several evaluation efforts to implement this priority. The development of a standardized template for statewide and county specific reporting of mental health priority indicators is an important step to understanding and measuring the impact of the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA). The MHSOAC has a contract with the Regents of the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) to develop, among other deliverables, standardized templates for reporting the priority indicators (Deliverable 2A) and to document the procedure for compiling the data to produce the standardized reports (Deliverable 2C). The contract requires UCLA to obtain stakeholder input on these two deliverables and provide revised deliverables in response to the stakeholder input obtained.

At the July 28th MHSOAC meeting the Commission will receive a presentation by Elizabeth Harris, PhD, Evaluation, Management and Training Associates who is working with UCLA on the draft Deliverable 2A and Deliverable 2C reports upon which public input is being sought. These draft reports will be available at the meeting.
