BACKGROUND:

In August 2011, the Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSOAC) entered into an interagency agreement with Regents of University of California, University of California Los Angeles (UCLA) to provide a summary and synthesis of existing Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) programs. All counties except small counties are required to conduct an evaluation of one of their PEI programs. In light of the early stages of PEI implementation UCLA summarized and synthesized the intended outcomes of these local evaluations, which, if conducted as planned, will eventually provide data on various domains of prevention and early intervention. The findings and broad recommendations provided by UCLA can be useful to inform counties and strengthen future PEI evaluations.
