Measurements, Outcomes, and Quality Assessment (MOQA) Data Report

Summary: The Measurements, Outcomes, and Quality Assessment (MOQA) is an initiative from the County Behavioral Health Directors Association of California (CBHDA) that invites counties to provide input on behavioral health outcome domains. In an attempt to support counties in their efforts to conduct evaluation that can be used to demonstrate the impact of the Mental Health Services Act, CBHDA has identified a series of outcome domains that counties can use to guide their individual evaluation approaches. The Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission has invited CBHDA to provide an overview of MOQA and its intended purpose.
