CONFLICT-OF-INTEREST CODE

Amend the Conflict of Interest Code to read as follows:

The Political Reform Act (Government Code Section 81000, et seq.) requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict-of-interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, 2 California Code of Regulations Section 18730, ~~which that~~ contains the terms of a standard conflict-of-interest code, ~~which can be incorporated by reference, and which may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act after public notice and hearings.~~ in an agency's code. After public notice and hearing, the standard code may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. Therefore, the terms of 2 California Code of Regulations Section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission, ~~along with the attached appendix in which commissioners and employees are designated and disclosure categories are set forth,~~ are hereby incorporated by reference. This regulation and the attached Appendix A, in which officials and employees are designated and Appendix B, in which disclosure categories are set forth are hereby incorporated by reference and constitute the conflict-of-interest code of the Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission.

~~Designated employees~~ Individuals holding designated positions shall file their statements of economic interests with the Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission, which will make the statements available for public inspection and reproduction. (Gov. Code Sec. 81008.) Upon receipt of the statement(s) of the Commission Members, ~~Alternate Members,~~ and the Executive Director, the ~~agency~~ Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission shall make and retain copies and forward the original of the statement(s) to the Fair Political Practices Commission. Elected state officers (State Senator and State Assembly member) do not file a statement of economic interests under this conflict-of-interest code. The statements for these officials are filed with the Fair Political Practices Commission. ~~All other statements for all other designated employees~~ will be retained by the ~~agency~~ Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission.
