Policy and Procedures Paper - How Evaluation Efforts Can Contribute to MHSOAC-Adopted Oversight and Accountability Strategies: Encouraging Positive Outcomes Across the State (Second Read)

Summary: Dr. Renay Bradley, Director of Research and Evaluation, Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSOAC), will present an overview of the MHSOAC Evaluation Committee adopted draft of the Policy and Procedures Paper, “How Evaluation Efforts Can Contribute to MHSOAC-Adopted Oversight and Accountability Strategies: Encouraging Positive Outcomes Across the State.” This paper was presented as a first read at the August 28, 2014 MHSOAC meeting and is being presented at the September 30, 2014 meeting as a second read.

The paper provides a series of policies and procedures for how evaluation efforts can contribute to the oversight and accountability strategies the MHSOAC adopted within its Logic Model in 2011. At the August 28, 2014 Commission Meeting, the Commission requested that the Logic Model be updated and presented to the Commission again for potential adoption. As such, the Commission is being presented with an updated Logic Model during the presentation of the second read of the Policies and Procedures Paper. The Commission will be asked to approve both the updated Logic Model and paper so that both documents can guide future oversight and accountability strategies and actions.
