Agenda Item 2 Presentation:

This item is an update to be presented by Sandra Villano, CFLC member, who is participating on the Evaluation Advisory Group (EAG) under the MHSOAC contract and is developing deliverables regarding the recovery orientation program evaluation. The EAG has been convened by the University of California San Diego (UCSD), as the contracted agency responsible for completing deliverables for this project. UCSD is required to utilize stakeholder involvement, as defined below, as advisors to provide input on the development of specific deliverables in a meaningful and appropriate way.

To date, the UCSD has conducted three meetings with the EAG that convened on February 10, 2015, March 10, 2015, and April 14, 2015.

The update at the April 30, 2015 CFLC meeting will include activities from these EAG meetings.

Stakeholder involvement: UCSD shall convene a group of stakeholder advisors to provide input on the development of the deliverable in a meaningful and appropriate way. Stakeholder advisors shall include (at a minimum) adults and older adults with severe mental illness, including those who have used or may be in need of services offered via the MHSA CSS component, and those in recovery; providers of services for adults and older adults; county representatives; and researchers/evaluators with expertise in recovery and/or recovery-oriented services for adults and older adults. A description of the stakeholder advisors and their involvement in the development of the deliverable shall be included in the deliverable report.
