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**BACKGROUND:**

The purpose of this evaluation effort is to provide counties with increased access to accurate and timely data through strengthening of the Client and Service Information (CSI) system, which collects data on all clients served via the Community Services and Support (CSS) component of the MHSA.

This presentation will present work that the Mental Health Data Alliance (MHDATA) has done to make use of CSI data for evaluation purposes. The Evaluation Committee will be asked to review and provide feedback on presented research to help shape research briefs that will be used to further inform counties about the current work that Full Service Partnerships have accomplished throughout the State.

Results to be presented will address the following questions:

- Does the MHSA help reach underserved youth in need?
- What are the drivers of county-level uptake for youth-serving FSP programs?
- Changes in mental health emergency services for youth served through FSPs

**ISSUE:**

MHDATA is in the process of completing two research briefs for the Commission as part of a contract deliverable. They are seeking guidance as to how to frame the findings so that they will be most beneficial to the State and counties.
