


CRDP Overview

- Community Mobilizing/Grassroots Partnership
- This is a key statewide policy initiative to improve:
 - Access to care
 - Quality of care
 - Positive mental health outcomes for racial, ethnic, and cultural communities
- Community-Defined Evidence (CDE):

Community-Defined Evidence Practice (CDEP)

- Community-Defined Evidence Practice: A set of bottom-up practices derived from a community's ideas of illness and healing or positive attributes of cultural or from traditional practices. In addition, the practice has been used by the targeted community, which has determined it to yield positive results through community consensus. These services are often culture-specific practices that are supported by community experience but not yet recognized or funded by the public mental health system.






Population Reports

Native American:


- 314 Native American community members and staff from behavioral health related programs
- 11 Regional Focus Group Gatherings
- 1 statewide conference



Population Reports (Cont.)

LGBTQ:


- 12 Community Dialogue meetings
- 4,200 surveys
- 400+ people provided input into the survey development
- Over 3,000 CA residents who identify somewhere on the LGBTQ spectrum, responded to the survey



Population Reports (Cont.)

African American:


- ▣ 35 focus groups
- ▣ 43 one-on-one interviews
- ▣ 9 public forums
- ▣ 635 surveys administered
- ▣ 6 small group data collection meetings held
- ▣ 1,195 “unduplicated” individuals, statewide



Population Reports (Cont.)

Asian/Pacific Islander:


- ▣ API communities from 5 CA regions
- ▣ 30 regional meetings
- ▣ 5 statewide meetings
- ▣ 12 Steering Committee meetings
- ▣ 23 focus groups
- ▣ 8 community forums
- ▣ 1 statewide conference
- ▣ 420 API community members



Population Reports (Cont.)

Latino:

- ▣ 14 community forums in 4 designated CA mental health regions
- ▣ 2 regional conferences
- ▣ An estimated 1,100 Latinos offered their perspectives on mental health services and strategies to reduce disparities









CRDP Functional Program Model




CRDP Solicitation Current Status
