Issue:

Review May 2015 Draft Financial Report

Based on the Governor's May Revision of the FY 2015/16 State Budget, released on May 14, 2015, the Financial Oversight Committee will review a draft of the May 2015 Draft Financial Report which includes the following information:

- MHSA Major Funding Sources
- MHSA Funding (Cash Basis)
- Mental Health Services Fund Distributions
- MHSA State Administration Funds
- MHSA Housing Funds

Background:

Financial Framework Overview

In January 2009, the Commission directed the Mental Health Funding and Policy Committee to develop a financial framework to guide the development of regular financial reports and identify key financial information relating to both the MHSA and public community mental health funding. The Financial Framework Overview was adopted by the Commission in April 2009, addressing the full cycle of public community mental health funding, which is comprised of revenue sources (money going in), the distribution of funding to counties (money going out) and MHSA expenditures (money utilized). The framework also identifies the timeframes in which information will be reported based on availability of financial updates throughout the year.

At the January 16, 2015 Financial Oversight Committee meeting, the membership reviewed the draft Financial Report and the majority of the suggested changes have been incorporated into the enclosed document.

Ongoing Financial Reports

The Financial Oversight Committee presented the first Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission Financial Report in January 2010 and an updated Financial Report in May 2010. These reports will be presented on an ongoing basis in January and May of each year.
