- There will be a revised questionnaire that will be pilot tested at the Amador County Forum and the participants will include clients, family members, and transition age youth. The revised questionnaire will include demographic survey information and open ended questions.
- The last forum for 2015 to be held in Fresno County will also outreach to community leaders and engage underserved groups. The forum structure will be considerate of ways to explore how to make this new structure work well.
