San Francisco County Innovative Project

San Francisco County is requesting \$2,001,600 dollars for a four-year Innovative Project titled:

Hummingbird Place Peer Respite

The project is Innovative as it will be located directly on hospital grounds and will divert those in crisis from the hospital to a setting that is better able to engage them in recovery work and with appropriate linkages to outpatient care. It will be entirely led by peer staff and the project will seek to separate out which practices guests participate in and which ones have the best outcomes.
