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ABOUT THE TOOLKIT

This toolkit is designed to provide a framework for California counties, agencies, organizations, and programs to conduct a process and outcomes evaluation of services provided by Peer and Family Support Specialists (PSS/FSS) for Transition Age Youth (TAY). A process evaluation examines how a program operates, if a program is meeting its operational goals, and operational barriers, while an outcomes evaluation seeks to measure the impact of a program on consumers' wellbeing. The toolkit is meant to provide a practical approach to evaluation of increasingly common TAY peer support programs, while accommodating counties and providers with less experience or resources to conduct TAY-specific evaluations.
