Motion 1

The MHSOAC moves to approve the funding levels proposed for PEI:

\$25M for Community Planning Process

Additional funding made available if needed from service dollars.

FY 07/08 \$90M

FY 08/09 \$192.6M

The MHSOAC supports release of DMH Draft PEI Guidelines with the addition of draft intent language dated 6/26/07

Technical Amendment-Juvenile Justice

Children and youth at risk of or experiencing Juvenile Justice involvement—Those with signs of behavioral/emotional problems who are at risk of or have had any contact with any part of the juvenile justice system, and who cannot be appropriately served through Community Services and Supports (CSS).

Votes: *Yes-10, No- 0, Not here- 6, Abstain- 0*

Technical Amendment to MHSOAC PEI County and State Level Policy Direction adopted 1-26-07- Trauma Exposed

Those who are exposed to traumatic events or prolonged traumatic conditions, including grief, loss and isolation, including those who are unlikely to seek help from any traditional mental health service

Votes: *Yes- 9, No- 0, Not here- 5, Abstain- 2*

Technical Amendment to MHSOAC PEI County and State Level Policy Direction adopted 1-26-07- Individuals

Experiencing Onset of Serious Psychiatric Illness

Those identified by providers, including but not limited to primary health care, as presenting signs of mental illness first break, including those who are unlikely to seek help from any traditional mental health service.

Votes: *Yes-8, No- 0, Not here- 5, Abstain- 2*
