If you are interested in participating, please read the submission guidelines below. Artwork with themes of wellness, recovery, and resiliency are encouraged.

**Submission Guidelines**

2. Because we have limited space, artwork will be selected based on the following criteria:
  - a. Appropriateness (i.e. no nudity or displays of violence)
  - b. Creativity
  - c. Emotional Expression
  - d. Overall Skill
3. If your artwork has been selected, you will be notified by email or phone by **April 12, 2013** with shipping instructions. The MHSOAC will cover the cost of shipping. We ask that all selected artwork be ready for shipment by **April 26, 2013**.
