

Measurements and Outcomes Committee
Report to MHSOAC
January 18, 2005

The outcome measurement tool for the Full Service Partnerships is complete and available on-line. It was essential to have this tool in place as the partnerships begin to provide service.

The Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Full Service Partnership (FSP) outcomes forms and Web-Based Data Entry technology are now available on the DMH MHSA website at <http://www.dmh.ca.gov/MHSA/AdviseComm.asp>. In addition, the final version of the matrix, entitled "Overview of DMH Initial Performance Measures for Full Service Partnerships," is attached to this email. DMH is currently planning to offer on-going trainings regarding these FSP outcomes forms and supporting technology, via webcasts and conference calls, beginning in late January.

Commissioner Jaeger has attended the Mental Health Department's Measurement and Outcomes Committee meetings and will attend the meeting on February 2 in Sacramento.

We have several recommendations regarding the structure of the MHSOAC's Measurements and Outcomes Committee which we believe require the concurrence of the commission.

There is a broadly representative advisory group working with the Mental Health Department's Measurement and Outcomes Committee. The committee is chaired by Stephanie Opredek, Ph. D. Commissioners Lee and Jaeger serve as liaison to this committee for the MHSOAC. A membership roster is appended.

We recommend that the MHSOAC Measurements and Outcomes Committee be structured as a small technical oversight group to work with the Mental Health Department's Measurement and Outcomes Committee while insuring the needs of the MHSOAC are met.

We further recommend that the MHSOAC Measurements and Outcomes Committee be authorized to retain a consultant, perhaps the group from UC Berkeley that spoke to the commission at the Oakland meeting. This would insure the scientific expertise needed to produce valid, usable outcomes data.

As we begin to see MHSOAC generated projects (innovation and others), the consultant relationship would insure the necessary expertise would be available to the commission.

Commissioners Lee and Jaeger will work with the Mental Health Department's Measurement and Outcomes Committee to develop a work plan and meeting calendar for the year.
